



During this wonderful, new decade of the 2020s, I have been living a renewed spirit of being positive, optimistic. Think, for a moment, of your response when you say or hear "2020 vision" = good, positive. Then, consider Angel Number 2020 = you have huge potential, use your gifts and talents to better the world, optimism, peace, harmony, determination. I needed all this emphasis on the positive following events which occurred in my life during 2019. In April, I began a series of traumatic health events: pain, CT scans, EKG, MRI tests. Diagnosis was degenerative, inflammatory, spinal arthritis. Medical attention moved from Silver City, New Mexico, to Tucson, Arizona, helicopter transfer to El Paso, Texas.

Information went to my Gloria de Cristo Church family/friends. My name was in the Prayer Chain and spread among many people. Through each step of this process, I realized that Jesus was at my side. Prayers were being answered. Guidance allowed me to make appropriate decisions. Never once did I hear God say, "That's enough with the prayers!" Distressing, agonizing, painful experiences led me through discussing and scheduling surgery, my children arranging and carrying out transfer from Texas to my northern home in Minnesota. Spinal arthritis (cervical 4-7 vertebrae) is regarded differently in Texas and Minnesota. Texas medical supervision is aggressive: get the patient into surgery and cut/fuse vertebrae. Medical supervision in Minnesota is conservative: monitor systems for symptoms, continue medication. I presented no symptoms. In July, I was deemed healthy! Prayers answered! To this day, no recurrence of symptoms. Then, I proceeded with the decision from 2018: right knee replacement. Successful surgery was on July 23. Because I live alone in my home in Minnesota and have many steps in the home, I transferred from Mercy Hospital to Interlude West Health Restorative Suites, Plymouth, Minnesota Campus. On August 2, I was discharged and in healthy condition. Prayers answered! I have heard from so many people in my life who have been thinking of me and praying for healing and success. All those "acts of kindness" allowed me to return to my home in Champlin, Minnesota. I believe in miracles: "a supernatural act of God where he intervenes in nature to alter an otherwise natural course of events." I did not die; I am no longer in a hospital; I will continue to be watchful for conditions requiring surgery. Then, my focus turned to preparation for return to the Foothills of Yuma and my Gloria de Cristo family/friends. I finally arrived on January 12. When I returned to worship, I was elated, uplifted to recite our Benediction: "Almighty God has created me and has a purpose for my life every day! Lord, help us remember, IF YOU ARE NOT DEAD, YOU ARE NOT DONE!"

Thankfully, we continue to recite those thoughts, now, in April! Prayers are answered!
